“Respect and honor goes both ways between human and horse” Missy says. “At the clinic women learned how to maintain a respectful position as the herd leader in their herd of two while empowering their gentle loving nature when around their horses. As a woman I understand our deep need to bond and build a friendship with our horses; as a horse trainer trust in my leadership is foundational to the horse’s nature. At the Woman to Woman clinics women learn how to balance their nature with their horse’s nature”.
